

Dr. Sinha graduated from Dartmouth College, followed by MD and JD degrees from Southern Illinois University in 2012 and an MPH degree in Law and Public Health from the Harvard T.H. Chan School of Public Health in 2015. He trained in internal medicine in Connecticut and Boston prior to joining the Program On Regulation, Therapeutics, And Law (PORTAL) at Brigham and Women's Hospital as a postdoctoral fellow in 2016. Since 2018, he has worked as a Research Fellow in Therapeutic Science at the Harvard-MIT Center for Regulatory Science at Harvard Medical School. Dr. Sinha is a nationally recognized speaker on gender equity in law and medicine and has published extensively in legal and medical journals. His most recent publications on gender equity with Dr. Julie Silver (Associate Professor at HMS and JCSW member) are in PM&R, EClinicalMedicine, and the Doximity blog. With Dr. Silver, he co-authored and shepherded the passage of comprehensive gender equity policy at the American Medical Association (AMA) and the Massachusetts Medical Society (MMS); they are currently working with the American Medical Women's Association (AMWA) to pass similar gender equity policy across all state medical societies. He is a member of AMWA, the AMA Women Physicians Section, the MMS Women Physicians Section Task Force, and the HMS Joint Committee on the Status of Women.
